

MAINE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP CENTRAL MAINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

In 1993, the Maine Chapter endowed a scholarship at Central Maine Community College. The Chapter elected this approach for their Chapter Scholarship activity as it assured scholarships would be distributed annually and that the endowment would be professionally managed.

The Central Maine Community College Scholarship is available to a student pursuing a career in architectural/engineering technologies, building construction, or mechanical drafting. The scholarship funds are administered by the institution and awarded based on criteria established by the Chapter

In addition to the scholarship award, all scholarship recipients receive a 1-year student membership in CSI.

The scholarship recipient is as follows:

Central Maine Community College Scholarship (2015-2016) For the 2015-2016 academic year, the following student received a scholarship worth \$500 and received a one-year membership in CSI.

Scholarship Criteria

Advancement of Construction Technology Scholarship at Central Maine Community College

Who is Eligible? College students with good academic standing after one year, with active involvement in a career or industry organization or association. Award goes to Maine Resident attending Central Maine Community College pursuing a career in architectural/engineering technologies, building construction, or mechanical drafting.

Scholarship Amount: \$500

How is scholarship awarded: Based upon above criteria and two written references.

Application process: At the Financial Aid Office of Central Maine Community College.

When can I apply for the scholarship? On or after January 1st each year.

What is application deadline? Completed applications must be received by date established by Financial Aid Office.

Number of Scholarships Awarded: One or more based on income from endowment.
